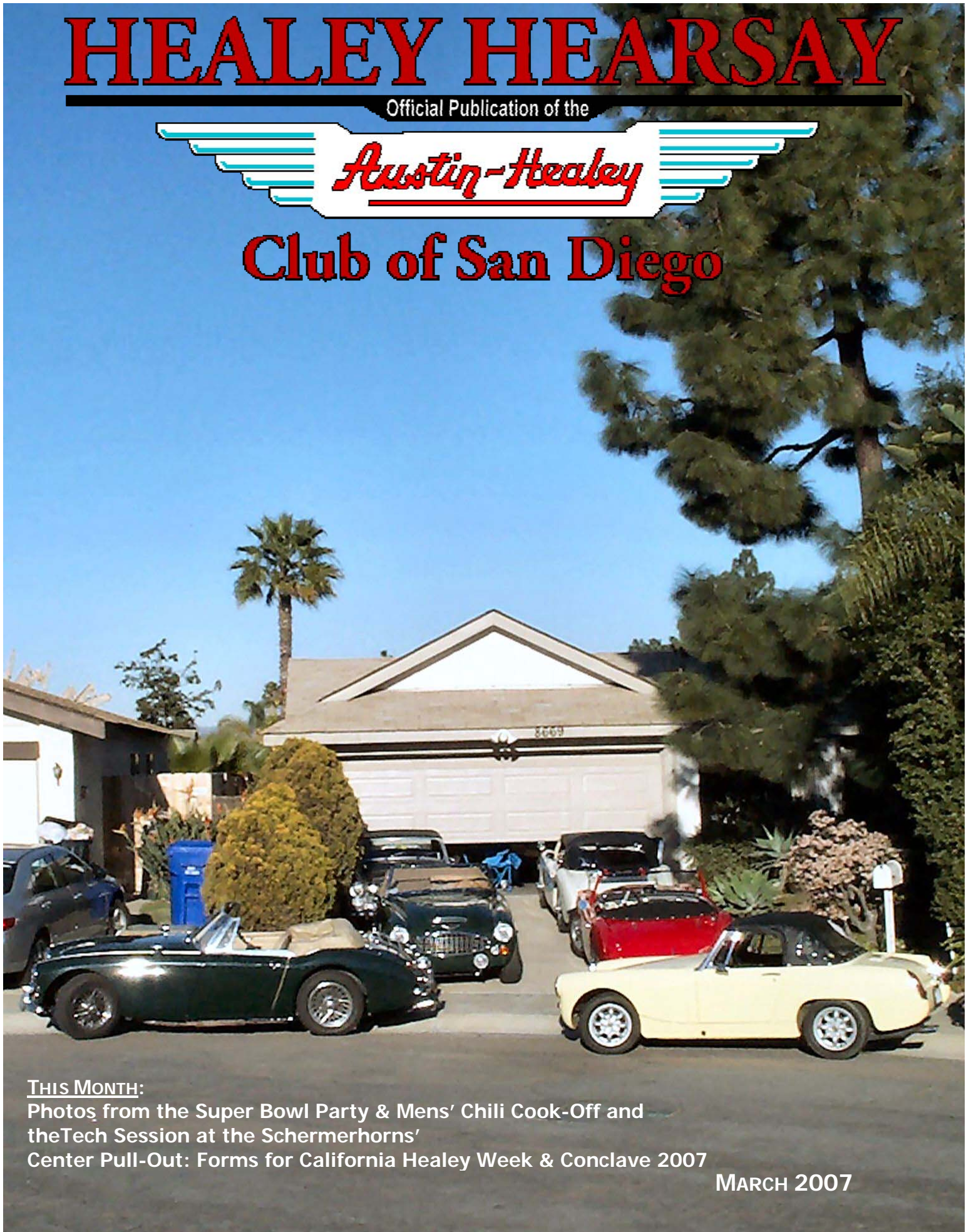

OLYMPIC TRAINING CENTER VISIT & BARRETT JUNCTION FISH FRY LUNCH

Saturday, March 24th

Due to the dearth of rain until quite recently, and the resulting poor forecast for the wildflowers at Borrego Springs, the Club's spring drive this year will be in the backcountry of southeastern San Diego County, starting at the Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista to Barrett Junction Café. It is a very, very nice drive – no road construction – along the Lower Otay Reservoir, out through the backcountry, and then onto Hwy 94. It is just starting to green-up with our recent rains but by March 24th it ought to be just beautiful.

We should meet at 11am at the Olympic Training Center (the gal at the Center said they sometimes don't open exactly at 10 am). There is plenty of free parking at the Center. Take about 30-45 minutes to explore the Visitors Center and Olympic Spirit Store (lots of really neat Olympic stuff to buy – sportswear, pins, etc.)

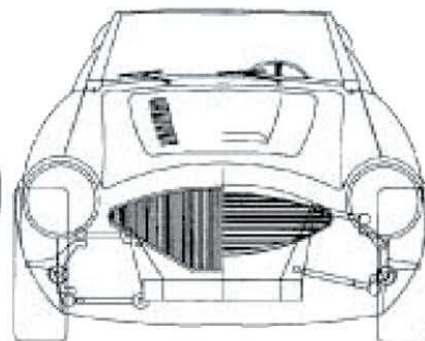

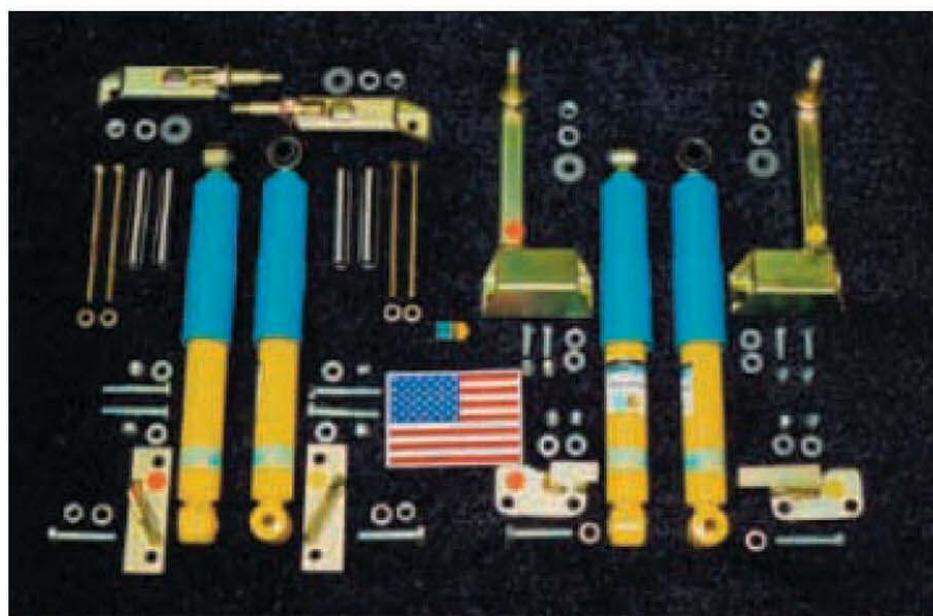
