It is with great sadness we have to announce the passing of John Healey, son of Donald Healey.


In recent years he, along with his wife Joy, had enjoyed many of the social activities of the Healey Clubs,



# Healey Bicycle - - ? ??

Quit a few of us received an email with this photo titled "Healey Bicycle" and no other information. Being a curious soul I went searching for more information. But an internet search for "Healey Bicycle" and "Vintage Bicycles" did me no good. I knew that there are several vintage bike folks on the Spridget list so I turn to them for help. Sure enough one of them identified the bike as the Bowden Spacelander Bicycle. This provided information and history on the bike (some of which follows) but shed no light on why the name Healey should be attached to the photo. So that part remains a mystery, at least for the moment.

Bowden Spacelander Bicycle

"The aluminum prototype of this futuristic bicycle was handmade by the MG Auto Company in England in 1946 and incorporated an ingenious dynamo that stored the downhill energy and released it on uphill runs. It was prohibitively expensive for consumer production, but in 1960 Bowden contracted with Bomard Industries in Michigan, to produce a more mechanically conventional, one-speed version of the dynamic, organic design in fiberglass, a new design material. Ultimately the endeavor was too costly for Bomard Industries, as well, and the firm went out of business having manufactured only 522 examples."

"This bike was the most radical concept of it's time. It totally epitomizes the "Space Age" with it's design. This bike looks like it was designed for NASA. It is made up of fiberglass and features built in headlights and rear fender. Designed by Benjamin Bowden, there was a prototype built and displayed in 1948. The production bikes however were made and sold only one year, 1960."



CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCSD driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCSD one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCSD multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.
