Car Buyer's Tips, Services and Rights

Important Information for New and Used Car Buyer's

Now more than ever people are selling their cars or trading them in for something a little older and a little less expensive. Whether you are part of this downgrading/downsizing trend or even upgrading to a new car, it is important to know your rights as a car buyer. The California Department of Motor Vehicles wants to ensure that customers are being vigilant when buying their vehicles and are aware of their rights, as well as possible hazards associated with purchasing a vehicle. Listed below are tips for smart car shopping, DMV services that are useful when buying a car and the legal rights of new and used car buyers.

Tips:

- Read and understand your purchase contract - Do not sign anything you don't understand
- Compare interest rates - Obtaining the best possible interest rate can significantly affect the overall cost of your vehicle
- Know the value of the vehicle - Visit Kelley Blue Book at www.kbb.com to learn the suggested retail value of the car you are purchasing
- Read your warranty - Be sure to fully read and understand the manufacturer's warranty and any additional warranties offered by the dealer

Services:

- Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator online- Determine your VLF, use/sales tax and additional fees before purchasing your car by visiting <https://mv.dmv.ca.gov/FeeCalculatorWeb>.

Rights:

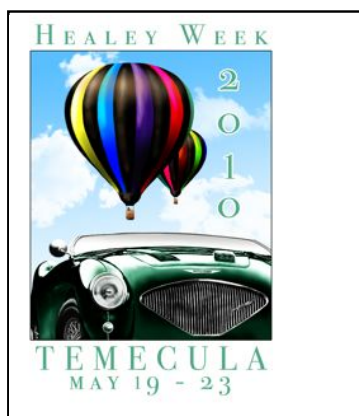
For new and used car buyers:

- Dealers must provide an itemized price list of items such as warranties and insurance, etc., if the items are being financed
- Dealer compensation from an institution financing the purchase of a vehicle is limited to no more than 2 percent for a loan term over 60 months and 2.5 percent for a loan term of 60 months or less
- Dealers must provide buyers with their credit score and an explanation of how it is used
- A new car buyer may purchase a two-day contract cancellation option agreement

For used car buyers only:

- A used car buyer may obtain a two-day sales contract cancellation option
- Used cars advertised as "certified" must meet specific requirements such as:
 - Odometer indicates the actual mileage of the vehicle
 - The vehicle was not purchased under state or federal warranty law (repurchased by the manufacturer or dealer)
 - The vehicle was not damaged by collision, fire, or flood unless repaired to safe operational condition prior to sale
 - The title was not branded as a Lemon Law Buyback, manufacturer repurchase, salvage, junk, non-repairable, flood, or similar designation.
 - The vehicle does not have frame damage or was sold "as is"
 - The seller should provide the buyer with a complete inspection report of all components inspected

By following these bits of advice and being an informed car buyer, you can save yourself time and money. For more information on car buyer's rights, smart shopping tips and many services available by the DMV online, visit www.dmv.ca.gov. Save time. Go online!

Track Day March 6th

We hope that you have received the announcement and registration form for the very special Track Day at Auto Club Speedway event on March 6, 2010. If you have not already done so you can complete and return the attached forms to VARA as instructed to sign up for this one of a kind chance to drive your car on the big oval used by NASCAR and the road course used by the American Le Mans series.

Events of the day and other options can be found on the club website (www.austin-healey.org) by clicking on the March 6 date on the calendar.

For those of you who have already made plans to attend here are some details:

- No special preparation of your car is necessary for you to run the event on the track. Your tires & brakes should be in good condition and fluid leaks should be minimized. Frank Monise will be performing a courtesy tech inspection of your car should you so desire on the morning of the event from 7:00 to 8:00 am.
- Roll bars are not required as there will be no "wheel to wheel" racing. Seat belts are required for the driver and any passengers.
- No helmets are required. Adjustable windscreens must be in the raised position.
- The track at Fontana is comprised of half of the NASCAR oval and a full road course in the infield of the oval. Maximum speeds will be dictated primarily by the driver's own level of comfort within the context of the "no passing" rule and the pace set by the lead pace driver. Transponders will be available for rent to anyone that would like their lap times recorded.
- A special drivers meeting will be held in the morning prior to the first session on the track. Both morning and afternoon sessions will allow approximately 10-15 laps per session.
- Photographs will be available of your car on track. We have arranged for a race photographer to take pictures of your car on the track which will be available for purchase after the event. Pictures of your car on track are something that you will cherish forever.
- Trophies will be awarded in different classes based on the number and model of registered cars.

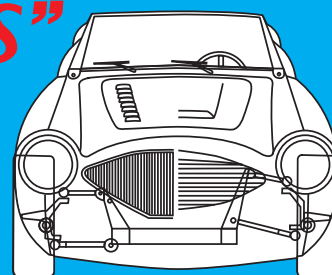

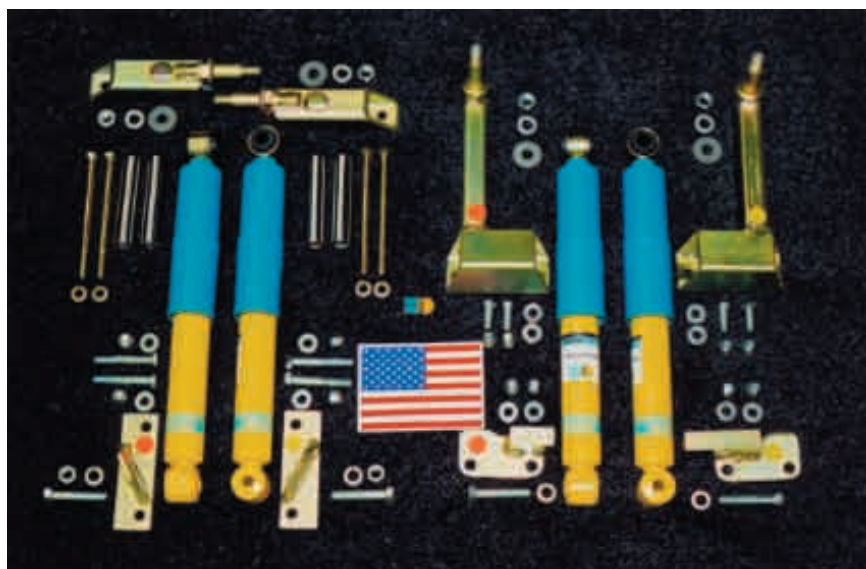

CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSd Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCSd driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCSd one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCSd multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.

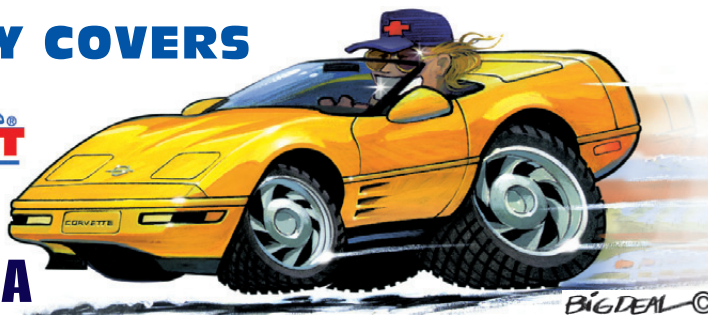
