



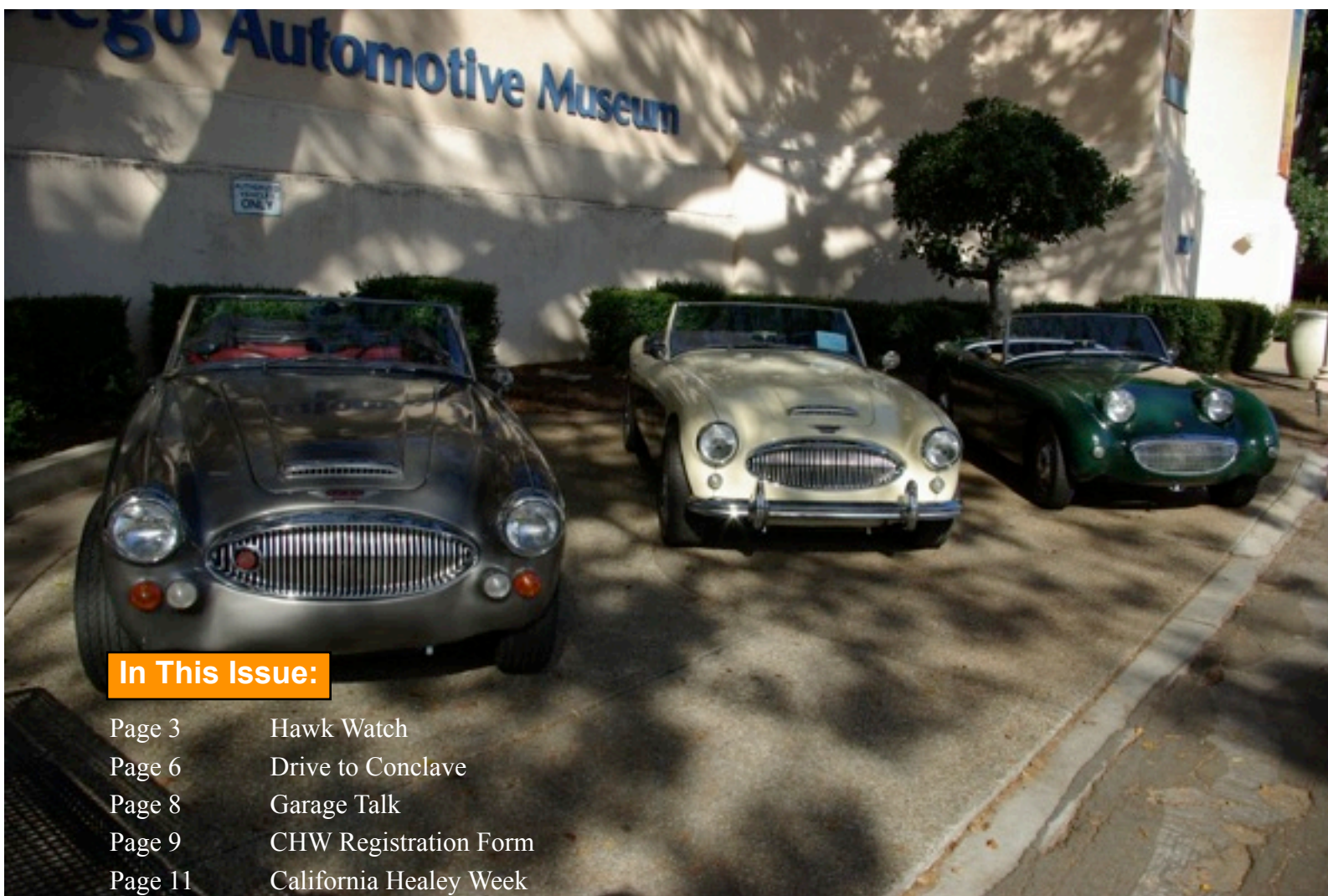

Get your Car sound and safe with all liquids, air, brakes serviced before we take off. The tour will go over some Mountain passes like: Coalbank Pass 10,910ft, Red Mountain Pass 11,018ft and some more. Our cars will run rich in the mountains, but we will not adjust the carburetors on each hill, we just go slower in 3rd gear and keep the ventilator spinning.

Each person needs to get a "Western States Provinces" map from the AAA. Or, you can get maps of California, Arizona, Utah, and Colorado and have the route highlighted. GPS will help you but, the tour will not be loaded into your GPS.

Garage Talks



As I drove up I saw a Healey parked in the drive under a cover. The McVeetys make it a habit of leaving

their home in Alpena, Michigan to follow the sun to San Diego. John met me at the door and we sat down and talked about his BJ8. He bought it new back in the late 60s and drove it every day, even in Michigan winters. John was a hospital administrator who wrestled with all the issues of staffing, budgets, buildings, and all the other stuff necessary to turn doctors into heroes, and nurses into angels.

It is easy to spot a car that has been driven any length of time in the mid west. They are usually more rust than solid metal. John's BJ8 was no different. It suffered a hard life and gave its all ferrying John to work every day over snow covered and salted roads in hard winters. Consequently, it arrived at the place where many owners would have given up and sent it to the scrap yard. John, to

his credit, decided to bring it back to its former glory.

At that time he began to look for someone to do the restoration work.

Checking out the restoration ads, he found a bunch of less than satisfactory shops. His search finally led him to the Toy Shop in San Diego and Terry Cowan. Yep, our Terry. They agreed on a plan to restore the car for parts and labor. So bundle up the car, ship it to San Diego and let the work begin.

The journey back from the scrap yard to concourse is a long and expensive one. Neither

John nor Terry understood just how far gone the car was until they began to work on it. It was a matter of finding a



worn out, rusted out part and replacing with a shiny new one, then finding another and replacing it, and another, and

another, and on and on. John said if he knew how bad it was in the beginning he would never have gone ahead with the restoration. But dealing with it bit by bit masked the enormity of the job. None the less, the finished product is a work of art and a testimony to the quality of work that

comes out of the Toy Shop. John is not finished with the car, there is still work to be done. Terry did NOT restore the back window!



The conversation with John was delightful. His house in Alpena is on Thunder Bay in Lake Huron. Living on the water like that can mean only one thing. He is into sailing. His wife, Katharine, is into horses. He has his boats and she has her horses. Coming to San Diego scratches more than one itch. The BJ8 can visit the Toy Shop, John can go sailing, Katharine can go riding with her friend in Poway, plus one of their kids lives nearby.

You might notice John has a slight limp. He found a worn out hip (I don't know if it was rusted out) and had it replaced with a shiny new one. Now he is looking at replacing the other worn out hip in April. I guess you could say John and his BJ8 have something in common. They are both being restored and looking forward to many more good miles.

And no, the Toy Shop does not do hip replacements.

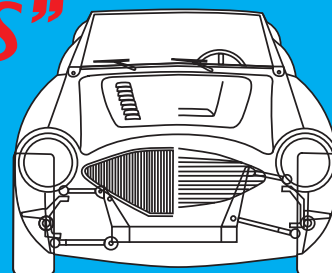




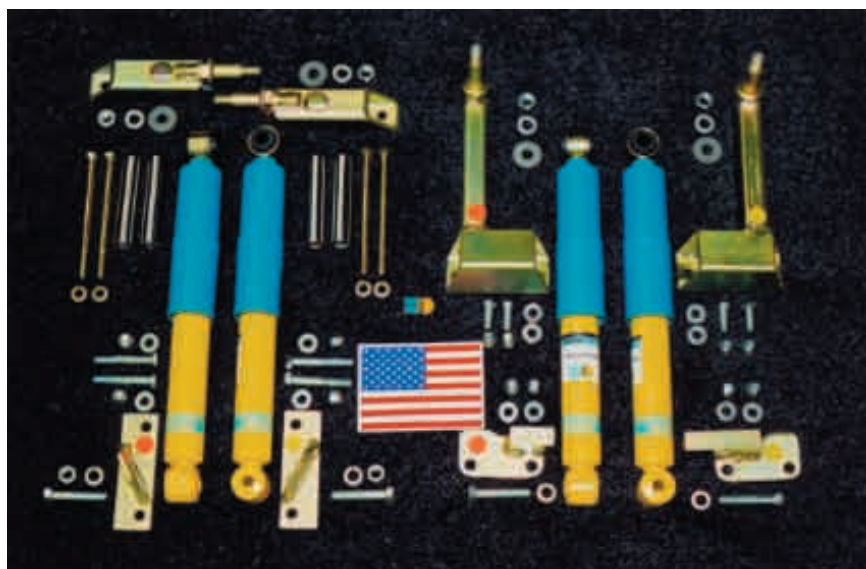

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the CotY recorder, Gisela Putzke (858-486-3870 or putzke@cox.net), within 30 days after the event. AHCSO events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For multi-Healey families, be sure to indicate which car(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSO Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCSO driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCSO one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCSO multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.
