








a couple differences. First there was the Bar-B-Q the night before. It still needs to work its way into the culture of the BCD, but it was a great success expecially among those who came from a great



Her name is **Mary Jane Schmidt** (no, she is not related to Dick and Jan) and she is





willing fingers to join into the mix. The colors included a jar of R.I.P. Black, Midnight Blue Sparkle,




Electric Orange and a
