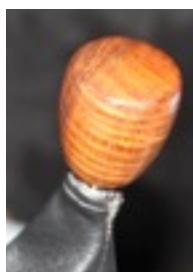


**From The Editor:**

The club also gave Bob a Vine Braided Ficus & Blue Glazed Ceramic Planter as a remembrance of Sue.

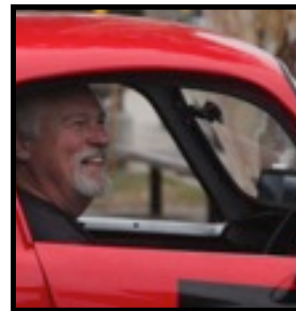

their



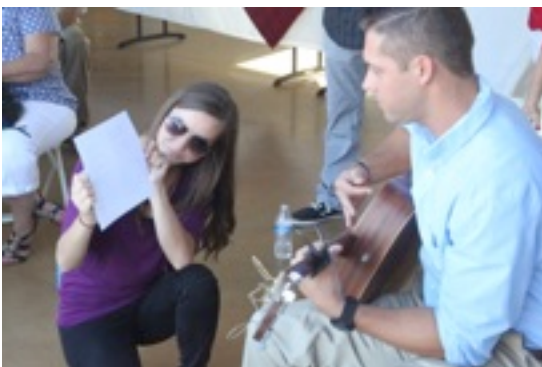
neighborhood in Ramona, and from their past. The couple involved in that blind date that started it all were there, as well as Rick's two friends from high school.

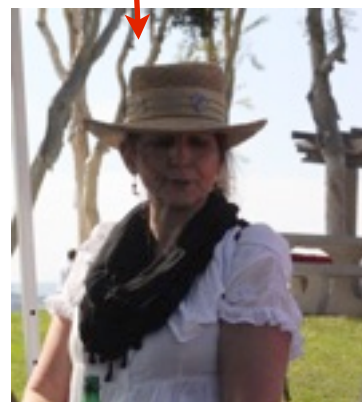
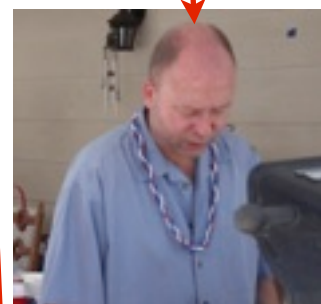

Car of the Year Award

These events may or may not be listed in the newsletter. The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the CotY recorder, Rick Snover (619-980-4194 or ricksnover@earthlink.net), within 30 days after the event. AHCS D events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For multi-Healey families, be sure to indicate which car(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCS D Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCS D driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCS D one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCS D multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.

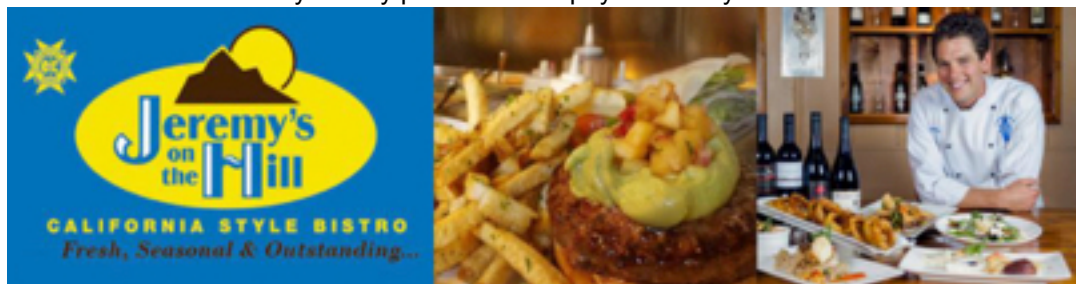
(Just east of I15 off of Scripps Poway Parkway—1st street north)

This year we have brought the wineries to a very nice restaurant for your enjoyment.

Chef Jeremy has selected a menu for your gastronomic delight.

We will have a wine tasting first and then have a sit down lunch where you will order from the chef's menu. Adult beverages, including any wine tasted, coffee, tea, and soda are available. All items are priced individually so that you only purchase and pay for what you desire.



Wine tasting from these select wineries: La Serenissima Vineyards and Winery, Tony will bring his 2013 Arneis, his 2010 Claret and his 2011 Syrah. The Arneis is \$20 a bottle, the Claret is \$23 a bottle, and the Syrah is \$25 a bottle. Milagro Farms will be bringing their 2013-Sauvignon Blanc their 2012-Barbera, and their 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon.
