

For almost a year I have been squirming around searching for a position that did not hurt. Getting in and out of Whooeee was almost impossible and working on Stella was a symphony of pain too. Hence my whole Healey experience suffered. Then it came to me, I could keep on in this miserable condition or I could bite the bullet and go for surgery. I have been warned by even experts that surgery is a risk and it may make things worse. My walking days could be over. Not lightly and not without prayer, I made the decision to have surgery. Thursday, September 25 was the date.

After all the necessary pre-op sessions, I checked in to Kaiser and they took my

clothes and put me in one of those gowns that don't quite come together in the back and I think I mooned all the nurses and half of my family. The Doc came in and drew a line on my back with a Sharpie, then they rolled me into the operating room. The anesthesiologist asked if I wanted him to sing me a lullaby and I said "yes." Then next I knew I was in a recovery room hooked to a tangle of wires and tubes. The next day the Doc came in and said I could go home if I passed the two tests. First, I had to prove I could walk and climb stairs. I aced that with no problem. Second, I had to pee. That took a little more doing. I think I drank a barrel of ice water but I managed to fill the cup by early afternoon and make it home before Bill O'Reilly came on TV.

I used a walker for about a week and I have been almost totally pain free ever since. Last Sunday was exactly one month since my surgery and I went on the platform at my church to thank all those who prayed for me and to demonstrate the answer to their prayers. I am basically pain free. **Praise the Lord!!**

Car of the Year Award

In an effort to recognize Club members who participate with their Healeys, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards Car of the Year (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect CotY points include any car-related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities) where you participate with your Healey. These events may or may not be listed in the newsletter. The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the CotY recorder, Rick Snover (619-980-4194 or ricksnover@earthlink.net), within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For multi-Healey families, be sure to indicate which car(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCSD driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCSD one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCSD multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.




