I hope you have cut your weed's back as they have gone from 4 foot green water filled crazy never seen the weed before, to dry laying down lite me on fire hazards so remember, cut, trim, remove so we don't read about any more club folks losing their homes, or their Healeys!!

On the tech front something to be aware of, the

Newest/Replacement Cut Off/safety switches which ALL big Healeys use

are faulty. If you have a good original unit, clean it up and put it back in your car, or **BYPASS** it by bolting the ground cable and the battery cable to one side of the switch, basically deleting the original idea of the switch, but if you leave the switch in place and use the off position it will still ground the ignition making it impossible to start.

The internal parts of the switch are so light weight in comparison to the original switch they can over heat and catch fire as the current is drawn over the shut off plate causing it to overheat internally and fail. And at times cause a fire by melting the **PLASTIC** they are now made of. This seems to happen after long start up loads...just another of the buyer beware things that plague the old car industry of late. Let me know if you need more info about this problem. MOSS says they are working on a fix, but

currently the switches are no longer available.

Racing, well while we didn't see any SD club folks at Sonoma, we did run into a couple of our racing Healey friends. One of which was Gary Cox who races the Healey Rossa which is a modified BN-1 with a Buick V-8. He ran with the big boys including Bill's most excellent XK-120 with

In Memoriam


We will miss our friend and former club member, **Dick Hoss**, who passed away last Saturday, June 24 of pancreatic cancer.

Car of the Year Award

In an effort to recognize Club members who participate with their Healeys, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards Car of the Year (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect CotY points include any car-related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities) where you participate with your Healey. These events may or may not be listed in the newsletter. The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the CotY recorder, Rick Snover (619-980-4194 or ricksnover@earthlink.net), within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For multi-Healey families, be sure to indicate which car(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 4 pts; AHCSD driving Events, Parties etc. 6 pts; California Healey Week 16 pts; Healey Rendezvous 16 pts; Austin Healey Conclave 16 pts; S.D. British Car Day & Rolling B.C.D. 10 pts; Other non-AHCSD one day events 2 pts; Other non-AHCSD multi-day events 4pts. The Board on a case-by-case basis may award points for other events.
