## Some people pay more than £6,000 for a sports car. Others prefer to spend £1,107 for an Austin Healey.



## Who needs to go faster than 130 mph?

At a recent count there were close to 20 people in Britain lucky enough (and wealthy enough) to own one of the fastest sports cars in the world. It costs more than  $\pounds 6,000$ .

A great many more motorists content themselves with a sporting 130 mph (the top speed of the Austin Healey 3,000) at a fraction of the price—£1,107.3.9, including £192.3.9 purchase tax.

Much has happened to the 3000 in the past year. Brake horsepower is up from 137 bhp at 4,750 rpm to 148 bhp at 5,250 rpm. Gear ratios and the twin carburettors have been modified to accommodate the extra power. Walnut and leather facings and a foldaway rear seat add luxury and convenience to an already superb interior. Production of the first 3000 series (Mark I) was begun in 1959. Since then the Austin Healey has accumulated thirty-four class wins in competitions around the world. This year's version (Mark III) won the Spa-Sofia-Liège Rally outright.

Its 2,912 cc engine will never win you a Grand Prix. Butacceleration from zero to 50 mph (with disc brakes



for safety) takes a mere seven seconds. And response from third gear is breathtaking.

Who needs to win a Grand Prix when an Austin Healey can do all that?





Austin Healeys are designed for the rest of us who want our lives to be the way we *wished* they were... the open road, the mystery around the next bend, the mineral smell of hot Castrol, the hypnotic drone of a straight six, (or four) too close to our feet, starlight overhead and city lights in the distance... It's more fun to imagine ourselves on the Tulip Rallye or maybe just vanquishing the Alps with Pat Moss as navigator...chatting about the evenings stop, dinner with fellow re-counters, talk about the quality of the local wines.."the beginning of a beautiful friendship", *gag, gag...yadda, yadda...* 

While we may lament the spotty quality of our loved (*or cursed*) cars, it is a major reason that they still retain cult status. There are just the right amount left. If they were as common as Toyota trucks, and as trouble free, and lasted as long, would we not be rolling them over cliffs, just to get rid of them?

# Car of the Year (CotY) Award

To recognize Club members who participate with their Healeys, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect COTY points include any car-related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities, etc.) where you participate with your Healey. Events need not be listed in the Club's newsletter to earn points.

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the CoTY Recorder, Rick Snover (619-980-4194 <u>ricksnover@earthlink.net</u>) within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.

COTY points currently approved by the Board are: AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 4pts; AHCSD Driving Events, Parties, etc. 6pts; AHCSD Healeys on the Green 8pts; California Healey Week, Healey Rendezvous and Austin Healey Conclave 16pts; S.D. British Car Day and Rolling B.C.D. 10pts; other multi-day British-themed events 8pts; other multi-day events 4pts; other one-day British-themed events 4pts; other one-day events 2pts. Other non-Healey British-built cars earn half points, but are not eligible to win the award.

All points received during the year by all members will be worth a discount towards the purchase of AHCSD regalia during the subsequent year. The total point leader at the end of the year will receive the coveted CAR OF THE YEAR badge for display on their Healey for the following year.
