CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) AWARD

To recognize Club members who participate with their Healeys, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect COTY points include any car-related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities, etc.) where you participate with your Healey. Events need not be listed in the Club's newsletter to earn points.

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the COTY Recorder, Rick Snover (619) 980-4194 <u>smokey.snover@gmail.com</u> within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.

COTY points currently approved by the Board are:

- AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 4pts
- AHCSD Driving Events, Parties, etc. 6pts
- AHCSD Healeys on the Green 8pts
- California Healey Week, Healey Rendezvous and Austin Healey Conclave 16pts
- S.D. British Car Day and Rolling B.C.D. 10pts
- Other multi-day British-themed events 8pts
- Other multi-day events 4pts
- Other one-day British-themed events 4pts
- Other one-day events 2pts.
- Other non-Healey, British-built cars earn half points, but are not eligible to win the award.

All points received during the year by all members will be worth a discount towards the purchase of AHCSD regalia during the subsequent year. The total point leader at the end of the year will receive the coveted CAR OF THE YEAR badge for display on their Healey for the following year.

I have loved the Austin Healev since I was a little girl. My car is a 1962 3000 MKII BT7. My dad got this car in the late 70's and restored it to everything original in 1980-82. He took his car with a trailer that he made from the back end of a Healey that couldn't survive and drove it to the Snowmass meet in Colorado from Eugene, OR while still putting the car back together. Every stop he would put something back on it. That car ended up winning best of show. This wasn't his first Healey, he fell in love with cars as a teenager working as a bellhop at the Biltmore Hotel in Santa Barbara in the late 50's. He had his first Healey in his early 20's but unfortunately sold it when he started a family as it was not a family car, but the longing for another was always there.

Spring forward to the 80's and he had this car and another one too. That one has a legendary story of running it into a creek upside down as he was the blind folded driver in a funkhana event. Anyway, that is a story for another time. I learned how to drive a stick shift in a Healey. My mom also had a Sprite that my brother still has.

As I grew up my love for these cars really grew. I enjoyed many outings as a kid in a Healey and my sister and I also sat in the back seat, if you can call it that many times and with the top up when it would rain, as it usually does in Oregon. We did a parade in town sitting in the Healey trailer throwing out candy.

For the 2008 West Coast meet held down here he left my husband and I the car to drive back up to Oregon. It was guite funny when we finally were unloading the car in Oregon and my dad watched us pull out I think a total of 36 bottles of wine. Luckily for us we didn't have to ship to much home as we were in town with a lot of family for an event so you can guess where it all went.

I have so many memories that include this car that I could fill an entire book and more. I am so blessed to have this car. My dad passed away unexpectantly in April of 2018 and I inherited it.
