February Meeting Minutes

AHCSD February 12, 2025 Meeting

President Laura Leyland called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

(H) = Drove Healey, (O) = Drove Other British

There were 15 members in attendance: Sandy & Lily Leon, Lex Dunn, Dave Grundies, John Lee, Joan & Bob DeYoung (H), Ed Matheus, Ron Richtmyer, Howard & Lynne Stark, Laura & Terrey Leyland, and Robert & Kathleen Reid

Laura Leyland opened the meeting and welcomed all, noting the DeYoungs were the only ones attending that had come in their Healey, especially impressive due to the current weather. She also thanked Joan and Bob for hosting the club at their home for a fun Super Bowl party. January meeting minutes were approved.

John Lee provided an update on membership. John is wrapping up membership for 2025 and he is not sending out more reminders. Everyone has renewed registration with the exception of 27 households. He inquired if anyone was having difficulty registering with Club America. Because finances are being handled separately, local members who wish to participate in the national club need to mail in check to complete their registration.

There was also a discussion of AHCSD being able to accept payments electronically through a service such as PayPal, Venmo, or Zelle. John Lee was going to explore advantages/disadvantages of each. Also, Club America reports that AHCSD is the only local club that does not have our local banking information registered with Club America, but we have no way to verify if this information is accurate. This is why there is confusion for paying dues online with the national club, who also wants to collect local dues, which AHCSD collects in a separate transaction. The question was brought into discussion if registering our information with the national club would be to our club's benefit or detriment.

Lynne Stark updated the club on the holiday party. The club covered all expenses incurred, breaking even. A profit was made with donations and sales of additional items. The group discussion recommended trying to book the party in the same location for this year. All were pleased with the food and ambiance. Lynne is also encouraging members to purchase club regalia including t-shirts (\$20) and tote bags. She has a catalog of items available and can also arrange for your own items to be personalized with the AHCSD logo or Healey Wings.

Laura Leyland reported back on the recent board meeting. The board has been discussing making changes to the Car of the Year (COTY) points and they way points are awarded. Discussions suggested increasing the points awarded for club attendance as well as giving more weight to club sanctioned events. Other awards being considered in addition to the COTY include: Member of the Year, Mileage Award, and a Hard Luck award. New points system will be voted on once developed.

California Healey Week is coming up and the AHCSD appears to have several members planning on attending. If you are interested in a travel caravan to the event, contact Lynne Stark. She will work on putting a travel group together with members who may be traveling on Sunday to perhaps Bishop, CA and then onward to the Yosemite site. There is a promo code on the event flyer that provides a third night free in the Yosemite Cabin Redwood.

Other upcoming events include Austin-Healey Assoc. of Southern California Festival of Whales at Dana Point on 3/8-3/9; AHCSD Wine Tour on 3/22; Rolling British Car Day (2 starting locations at Carlsbad or El Cajon/ending at Menghini Winery in Julian) on 4/6; Temecula Car Show cruise on 5/3; British Car Day on 10/19.

Kathleen Reid is (still) working with our web designer on a refresh. She needs to collect information on where our current website is hosted as well as the costs. Rick Snover will be able to provide that information. She would also like to collect car information and pictures to be included on the Member's Page.

Meeting was adjourned.





Car of the Year Award Standings

To recognize Club members who participate with their Healey's, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect COTY points include any car related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities, etc.) where you participate with your Healey. Events need not be listed in the Club's newsletter to earn points.

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the Coty Recorder, Rick Snover (619) 980-4194 smokey.snover@gmail.com within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are:

- AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 5pts
- AHCSD Driving Events, Parties, etc. 6pts
- California Healey Week, Healey Rendezvous and Austin Healey Conclave 20 pts
- S.D. British Car Day and Rolling B.C.D. 10pts
- Other multi-day British-themed events 8pts
- Other multi-day events 4pts
- Other one-day British-themed events 4pts
- Other one-day events (Cars & Coffee, etc) 1pt. 10 pt limit annually.
- Other non-Healey, British-built cars earn half points, but are not eligible to win the award.

The total point leader at the end of the year will receive the coveted CAR OF THE YEAR badge for display on their Healey for the following year.




