

June Meeting Minutes

AHCSD June 11, 2025 Meeting

President Laura Leyland called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM

General Business

- There were 21 members in attendance: Lex Dunn, Don Benke (H), John Lee & Susana Davis (H '67 BJ8), Howard & Lynne Stark (H), Laura & Terrey Leyland, Tom Luckie (H), Robert Reid, Rick & Allie Snover, Jim Doornink, Terry Cowan (H), George Williams (H), Alex Watt, Lou Galper & Deb Durham (H), Steve Gerow, Ed Matheus, Ron Richtmyer.
- Laura Leyland opened the meeting, welcomed all and thanked members in attendance. She gave a reminder about CHW coming up in October. Again, there was discussion about AHCA collecting the AHCSO local dues and reimbursing them to the AHCSO bank account. This was met with mixed responses. It was noted that this is currently the only way dues can be paid with a credit card rather than mailing a check. There is disagreement about providing AHCA our bank information. AHCA told John Lee that we'd get reimbursement within 1 week.

Car of the Year Award Standings

To recognize Club members who participate with their Healey's, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect COTY points include any car related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities, etc.) where you participate with your Healey. Events need not be listed in the Club's newsletter to earn points.

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the COTY Recorder, Rick Snover (619) 980-4194 smokey.snover@gmail.com within 30 days after the event. AHCSO events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.

COTY points currently approved by the Board are:

- AHCSO Meetings & Tech Sessions 5pts
- AHCSO Driving Events, Parties, etc. 6pts
- California Healey Week, Healey Rendezvous and Austin Healey Conclave 20 pts
- S.D. British Car Day and Rolling B.C.D. 10pts
- Other multi-day British-themed events 8pts
- Other multi-day events 4pts
- Other one-day British-themed events 4pts
- Other one-day events (Cars & Coffee, etc) 1pt. 10 pt limit annually.
- Other non-Healey, British-built cars earn half points, but are not eligible to win the award.

The total point leader at the end of the year will receive the coveted CAR OF THE YEAR badge for display on their Healey for the following year.


